

He is a 1988 graduate of Northwestern's School of Education and four-year letter winner in basketball where he was a 1,000-point scorer, the 1987-88 Playboy Magazine Anson Mount Scholar-Athlete of the Year and a two-time CoSIDA Academic All-American. Shon continues to serve as a basketball analyst for Northwestern games on WGN Radio, and also does game analysis and studio work for

year by the Norwegian King Harald, noting his work in fostering Norwegian-American relationships.

The award was witnessed by about 50 friends and relatives of Don's as the Norwegian Ambassador, H.E. Wegger Chr. Strommen presented the award in a short but solemn ceremony. Leading the event was our own member, the Honorary Norwegian Consul General, Paul Anderson. The master of ceremonies was Orion Samuelson, Radio Broadcasting Hall of Fame recipient known for his farm reporting for WGN radio. Orion had also acknowledged Don in his early morning broadcast that day.

After an excellent dinner, the speeches were given by all, including Don himself. Don's contributions to fostering Norwegian American relations was made known, including those which many of us at the Torske Klub have witnessed. We already know about his contributions to the Chicago Torske Klub as Assistant Boss and as Program Chairman in years past. He grew the membership of the Norwegian American Chamber of Commerce (NACC) exponentially under his leadership and in that same group he formed multiple tours to Norway. These trips were not just random wandering, but they hosted specific leaders in various fylke (counties) and cities of Norway. Those leaders have become regular visitors and friends of the Chicago Norwegian American community. He is a regular host to dignitaries from Norway. Not bad for a Norwegian – American farmer who rose to become the managing director of Marsh & McClellan Insurance.

By the way, Don hasn't rested since receiving the award (and we're not talking about his avid golfing hobby). It was announced last month that he is developing a Chicago Torske Klub sponsored trip to the Lofoten Islands in Norway for touring and torsk fishing for sometime in the summer 2010 timeframe. About the Medal: The Royal Norwegian Order of Merit was founded by King Olav V in 1985. It is conferred on foreign and Norwegian nationals as a reward for their outstanding service in the interest of Norway. His Majesty The King is the Grand Master of the Order.
