Greetings from SPC Daniel C.

Greetings!

Since I left you fine folk in March last year I have been working steadily through my training as an Army Linguist. After completing Basic Training at Fort Jackson, SC in June last year I was sent to the Defense Language Institute in Monterey, CA where I am currently two months from completing the 64 week Arabic Basic Course.

The Defense Language Institute traces its roots to the dawn of World War II when the Military Intelligence Service Language School was created to train Japanese linguists. The school expanded during the Cold War years and currently trains linguists for all US military branches and some allied nations.

Recently the top ten students in my class were selected to participate in an immersion program in Morocco. We spent 30 days in the capital, Rabat, from mid-June to mid-July. Surprisingly, Africa in July was very pleasant compared with the 100 degree weather Chicago was experiencing at the time. Rabat is right on the Atlantic coast and cool breezes kept the temperature in the 70s and 80s for most of my stay.

We spent weekdays in language classes with local teachers. On weekends we traveled to different cities around the country, including Fez, Marrakesh and Casa Blanca. During the week we stayed with local host families. They were very friendly hosts and it was a great way to experience everyday life in their culture. I spent most of the evenings watching and discussing the news with my host brothers in their sitting room.

There was plenty to talk about as the Egyptian presidential election, bloody rebellion in Syria, new accusations about Yasser Arafat's cause of death, and the Euro Cup soccer tournament were all going on while I was there.



It was a very comfortable stay and at the end of the trip we exchanged gifts. I gave one of the brothers a Chicago Cubs hat so that even if he never figures out American baseball he will at least know which team to support. The other brother is studying English so I gave him a copy of the first Harry Potter book and The Great Gatsby. I also gave the family a painted tablet which I had had inscribed with a verse about friendship from the Koran and a message of my gratitude for their hospitality. In return they gave me my very own jelljaba (man dress), a richly embroidered prayer rug, a copy of the Koran in English, and nice ring for my fiancé.

It was a slight readjustment coming back to Monterey and military discipline but I am looking forward to graduation at the end of October and

moving closer to the end of training. After language training there is another 4-6 months of training in what they actually want me to do with the language. After that, after more than two years and at least quarter million dollars worth of training, the Army is going to throw all that work out the back of an airplane at the US Army Airborne School.

I'm not sure when I will have the opportunity to be home on the second Saturday of the month, but until then, Skal to the Torske! Or في صحة السمك! (fiseha ahsamak; To the health of the Fish!) -SPC Daniel C.
