Ladies Day with Arctic Explorer John Huston

February is ladies day at the Chicago Torske Klub for the luncheon. All the ladies, wives, family and friends, are invited to attend. This month we correct the scheduling snafu from last year and present Polar Explorer and author John Huston. Mr. Huston has completed major expeditions to the North Pole, South Pole, on Greenland, and most recently on Ellesmere Island. In 2009, he and his expedition partner became the first and only Americans to reach the North Pole unsupported, a selfsufficient and self-powered journey of 55 days and over 500 miles.

In the spring of 2005, John was selected to join a team of Norwegians restaging Amundsen's 1911 expedition to the South Pole for the History Channel and BBC mini-series, Blizzard: Race to the Pole. The expedition team skied and

dogsledded 1400 miles over 72 days on the miles Greenland icecap, using only 1911 period clothing, equipment and food.

This spring John co-led a 65-day expedition to Ellesmere Island, Canada - one of the wild-

est and most remote regions in the Arctic. The documentary film about this expedition aired on Norway's TV2 this holiday season, North American distribution is pending.

A native of Evanston, Illinois, he is a speaker, writer, consultant, Normennenes Singing Society at the 109th and guide. In April of 2009 John and his expedition partner, Tyler Fish, became the first and only Americans to travel "unsupported"

from land to the North Pole. This 55-day, 475- mile journey has been accomplished by only 13 expeditions and has been called the "toughest expedition on the planet." To travel unsupported means to travel under one's own power without resupply. John's award winning book, Forward, will be available at the event. Jon Knudsen is our torskemaster.
