This has been newsworthy this year as it the 100th anniversary of this locally famous disaster. Mr. Wachholz is with the [Eastland Disaster Historical Society](#) and will be speaking with a slide presentation, along with the co-founders: Susan Decker and Barbara Decker Wachholz. These founders are the granddaughters (and only grandchildren) of brave survivor Borghild Amelia Aanstad. Borghild was nearly 14 years old when she boarded the Eastland with her sister Solveig, mother Marianne, and uncle Olaf (all of whom survived the tragedy). Thrown into the water, she was a very capable swimmer and able to keep her head




The Newgards on Oct. 15, 1955

October 9 is not associated with any particular event in Leif Erikson's life. The date was chosen because the ship *Restauration* coming from Stavanger, Norway, arrived in New York Harbor on October 9, 1825, at the start of the first organized immigration from Norway to the United States.
