



October Recognizes Reformation's 500th Year

We are pleased to welcome Prof. Ken Sawyer to our podium to talk about and celebrate the 500th Anniversary of the Protestant Reformation, which is October 31, 2017.

Ken Sawyer teaches at McCormick Theological Seminary, on the south side of Chicago, Illinois. McCormick is a Presbyterian seminary which welcomes a great variety of students from many traditions. He has been part of the McCormick community a long time, and rooted in and formed by the schools, libraries, and congregations of the south side. In serving a small school in response to the needs of our students, he has become a generalist historian-- teaching in each of the main periods of Western christian history: early, medieval, Reformation, early modern, and modern. He received the Ph.D. in the History of Christianity from the University of Chicago Divinity School where he studied with Martin Marty, Jerald Brauer, and Langdon Gilkey.

He will focus on the various renewal movements of the sixteenth century gathered under the title, the Reformation. He will review the main topics and leaders of these movements, and then turn to the religious, political, and broader intellec-
